



# Side Handle Baton Workshop

A side handle baton is a stick of less than arm's length, carried by security personnel for less lethal self defense, as well as control and to disperse combative and non-compliant subjects. It may be used to strike, block, and locks.

## Topics covered will include the following:

How to hold the side handle baton	Surprise attacks
How to strike/block correctly	Attack scenarios
Proper stances	How to apply locks using the side handle baton
Striking/Grappling Techniques	Close range fighting
